DIVISION OF AIDS (DAIDS) GRADING FOR SEVERITY OF ADRs TO ANTI-TB DRUGS

GRADE 1 MILD

Mild symptoms causing none or minimal interference with usual social & functional activities; intervention not required

GRADE 2 MODERATE

Moderate symptoms causing greater than minimal interference with usual social & functional activities; intervention required

GRADE 3 SEVERE

Severe symptoms causing inability to perform usual social & functional activities; intervention or hospitalization required

GRADE 4 POTENTIALLY LIFE-THREATENING

Potentially life-threatening symptoms causing inability to perform basic self-care functions; intervention required to prevent permanent harm, disability or death

GRADE 5 DEATH

> End of life
